Commissioners' Board Meeting Minutes January 13, 2011

The Berks County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Thursday, January 6, 2011, at 10:30 A.M. in the Board meeting room on the thirteenth floor of the Berks County Services Center, pursuant to due notice to Board members and the public.

Commissioner Chair Mark C. Scott, Esq. called the meeting to order with Commissioner Kevin Barnhardt in attendance. Commissioner Christian Leinbach attended Legislative Day at the Pennsylvania Farm Show in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Also present were Solicitor Alan Miller Esq., Kenneth C. Borkey, Jr., Interim Chief Operations Officer and Maryjo Gibson, Chief Clerk.

Commissioner Scott opened the meeting with a moment of silence and Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Approval of Minutes
