

BERKS COUNTY JAIL SYSTEM

DRESS CODE FOR PROFESSIONAL VISITORS

Jail staff reserves the right to deny anyone visiting privileges because of inappropriate dress. This is understood to be a subjective decision which will be made by an employee of the jail and cannot be appealed. Management can prohibit any clothing or accessories for safety, security, and/or professional decorum reasons at their discretion. You will be informed of the infraction and will be asked to leave, but may return when suitable attire is achieved. The Director or Department Head of the visitor's home agency are asked to convey these guidelines to all staff that enter the Berks County Jail System.

Unacceptable Attire - Includes But Is Not Limited To:

Cropped or halter tops-no midriffs may be exposed

Non-dressy T-shirts, tank tops

Any dress, skirt or skort worn above knee level

Shorts, sweat pants, jogging suits

Spandex or other form fitting pants

Casual sandals, sport sandals, or flip flops

Heels higher than 3"

Revealing, low cut, sheer and/or see through clothing

Visible body piercing jewelry

Toe rings, large hoop or dangle earrings

Inappropriate logos, pictures, or verbiage on any clothing

Clothing that is ripped, tattered, cut-off or have holes in it
