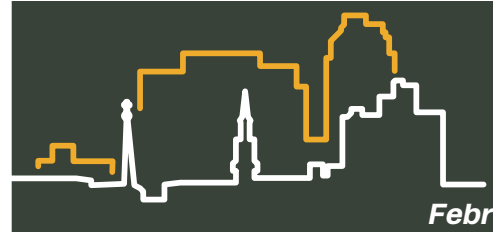

Nationwide, an estimated six billion gallons of water per day are taken from water resources and never reach the customer; this is enough to supply the drinking needs of the ten largest US cities. Many drinking water systems in Pennsylvania deliver water to customers through aging distribution systems; withdrawing, treating, and supplying water for which they may not be fully receiving revenue. To help water utilities address this growing issue, the PADEP: Safe Drinking Water Operator Outreach Program and the Delaware River Basin Commission are providing a free three-part training series on water loss management for water operators, water managers, water authority personnel, engineers, and water system board members.
