ORDER

AND NOW, this 13th day of April, 2020, it is hereby ORDERED that until further notice:

1. Currently scheduled in-person proceedings for custody, support and divorce are postponed and will continue to be rescheduled by the appropriate office, subject to paragraph 2, below, unless exigent circumstances are present, requiring a matter to be heard immediately. Exigent circumstances should be set forth in the pleadings or you can contact Family Court Administrator, Lisa A. Siciliano, Esquire by telephone at 610-478-6208 ext. 5771 or by e-mail at lsiciliano@countyofberks.com. Exigent circumstances will be communicated to the assigned Judge for review to determine when the matter should be scheduled.
2. The Court may reschedule non-essential custody, support and divorce proceedings for remote proceedings using advanced communication technology consistent with the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Orders and executive branch orders and guidance issued during the COVID-19 health crisis, as the Court deems appropriate. The appropriate scheduling office shall contact counsel and pro se parties for rescheduling purposes.
