

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF BERKS, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 05-2011, ENACTED DECEMBER 8, 2011, ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM WEIGHT LIMITS FOR ALL MOTOR VEHICLES, COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, AND OTHER TRACTORS, TRAILERS, AND TRACTOR-TRAILER COMBINATIONS UPON VARIOUS BRIDGES OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY THE COUNTY; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME; AND PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF FINES AND FORFEITURES.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2011, the Commissioners of the County of Berks enacted Ordinance No. 05-2011; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Berks desires to amend Ordinance No. 05-2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Berks, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same that the Ordinance No. 05-2011 is amended as follows:

1. In accordance Section 5(a) of Ordinance No. 05-2011, and based upon the recommendation of the County's Bridge Engineers, the Director of Facilities and Operations of the County of Berks hereby modifies and updates the Gross Weight limits on the list of County owned Bridges attached hereto and by reference made a part hereto.
2. The bridges set forth on the attached list shall be posted as set forth in Section 4 of Ordinance 05-2011 in accordance with applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania "Vehicle Code" and any other laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or section of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, and it is hereby declared to be the intention of the County Commissioners of the County of Berks that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause or section not have been included herein.
4. Any ordinance, parts of ordinances, resolutions or parts of resolutions conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance's provisions.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective at effective ten (10) days after its enactment by the Board of Commissioners of Berks County.
