



Voter Registration Drive FAQs

Who can register to vote in Pennsylvania?

To register to vote, you **MUST** be:

- A citizen of the United States
- A legal resident of Pennsylvania and the County in which you wish to vote
- At least 18 years old by Election Day



You may **NOT** register to vote if you are:

- Not a United States resident
- Serving a sentence for a felony conviction

What is required on the application?

- All fields on the application must be completed.
All new registrants must include their Pennsylvania driver's license number or the last four digits of their Social Security number.
- The registrant must **sign and date** the application in Box 11.
- Any individual assisting with the completion of the registration form must complete Box 12.



How should completed applications be returned?

- Delivered in person to the Berks County Election Services Office. The office is open Monday-Friday from 8 a.m.-5 p.m.

Tips for Running a Voter Registration Drive

DO

- Be aware of the **voter registration deadline** and plan accordingly.
All completed voter registration applications must be received by the Office of Election Services by the deadline.
- **Train** those conducting the drive to know who is eligible to vote and how to fill out the voter registration application completely and correctly.
- **Return all completed applications** in a timely manner to Election Services.
- Make the **best use** of the paper applications or encourage residents to register online.

DON'T

- Complete or accept applications from anyone who is **ineligible** to vote.
- **Refuse** to give a form to someone who wants to register based on their political party preference.
- Copy, disclose or make any use of the personal information disclosed on the completed applications.
- **Charge anyone** for a voter registration application or for helping them fill it out.
