AGENDA ITEMS

1. Logic & Accuracy (L&A) Testing

Ms. Norton explained that L&A testing is to test that all components of the voting system are properly configured and in good working order before Election Day. She announced dates, locations and times for all testing and stressed that this information will be posted on the Election Services website. The Board asked questions and made comments on the matter. On the motion of Commissioner Leinbach, seconded by Commissioner Rivera, the Board approved the schedule for Logic and Accuracy testing for Berks County Election Equipment.

ELECTION DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Norton shared that the sample ballots are posted on the Election Services website. There are approximately 17,400 mail-in/absentee ballots in the first group of ballots that will be mailed out. Information on over the counter voting will be posted on the Election Services website, once finalized.

Commissioner Rivera reminded voters about the upcoming registration and ballot deadlines and noted that drop boxes will open on May 4.


