#### a) Rentals (Susan)

b) Whole Homes Repair Program (WHRP). Tyler Reese advised the Board of the following: To date 2.3 million dollars have been spent on repairs between Reading and the rest of the county. 91 applications have been completed. 29 cases are approved and are in various stages of completion.

- c) <u>Colebrookdale Spur:</u> Mr. Pick advised of the following: We are still working on the financing package for the overall project to improve the railroad. We are hoping to have this accomplished by the end of June. In the meantime, we continue to look for additional funding sources for this project.
- d) Oley project: The project will be delayed due to a few site challenges with Met Ed. After meeting with Met-Ed, we have a game plan to continue the work. Tentatively, the project will be completed in December.

#### 9. New Business:

a. Resolution #2025-2 A description was given and a discussion ensued with Mr. Edelman, Mr. Dearstyne, and Mr. Peck regarding the financing between the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Berks and Reading Area Community College. A motion was made by Mr. Bassano and seconded by Mr. Yeager approving the financing for the 13M Revenue Note to Reading Area Community College.
